Evaluation System Use and Terms

Availability of the evaluation systems is limited. Preference may be given to agencies that are closer to deployment than initial evaluators. Evaluating agencies are responsible for the maintaining the proper condition of the evaluation equipment. If the equipment has been rendered inoperable due to conditions other than normal wear and tear, the agency will be obligated to replace the non-working equipment. FDDI will provide equipment check lists that will accompany the evaluation equipment. FDDI will also provide installation guidelines as well as operational guidelines to aid in the evaluation process. The evaluation system is available only to bonafide public safety agencies. All evaluators will be required to complete an evaluation form and return the form with the equipment. FDDI reserves the right to have the equipment returned or collect the equipment if any of the terms of the evaluation agreement are violated. The evaluation system is available for a 4 week period allowing for 1 week delivery and installation; 2 weeks of systems operations; and 1 week for dismantling and return. The evaluating agency will be responsible for shipment back to FDDI. FDDI will provide installation services at a reduced rate if the agency requires such services.
